

The Gray County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Friday, October 14, 2022, at 9:00 a.m. with Mark Busch, Glenn Oyler, and Ashley Rogers, County Clerk attending.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Building permit #2022-026, Abram Giesbrecht for a garage in the NW1/4 of Sec 18, Twp 25S, Rng 30W; was approved.

Brian McGrew and Sean Wendel entered the meeting at 9:30 a.m. Jeff Sharp and Colby Ellis entered the meeting at 10:00 a.m.

Jeff presented a bid for a new fingerprint scanner system. Mark made a motion to accept the bid of \$17,990.65 for a scanning system with computer and software from HID Global. Glenn seconded the motion. The motion carried. Payment will be from the Sheriff’s Account in the Equipment Reserve Fund. The bid is on file.

Once Jeff concluded, Sean presented (1) road crossing permit which was approved. He also discussed the driveways between buildings out at the recreation center. He was only able to get one bid for the job. Road and Bridge will remove the asphalt. Sean then presented a bid from Precision Builders, Inc for \$75,332.80 to repair the driveways. Mark moved to accept the bid and Glenn seconded. The motion carried. Payment will be from the Capital Improvement Fund. The bid is on file.

Sean then presented bids on chemical. Glenn moved to accept the bid of \$5,040.00 for Freelex chemical from Van Diest Supply. Mark seconded the motion. The motion carried. Payment will be from the Noxious Weed Budget. The bids are on file.

Sean then presented another bid for chemical for road & bridge. Glenn moved to accept the bid of \$24,637.60 for Glyphosate, Esplanade, and Vista chemical from Van Diest Supply. Mark seconded. The motion carried. Payment will be from the Road & Bridge budget. The bid is on file.
